Engineering Technology Company MEGGITT, decided to build a new manufacturing centre in the heartland of British engineering at Ansty Park, Coventry. They needed the best of catering facilities to sustain their Workforce Colleagues and so, through contractors Winvic, Inox Equip Ltd. were engaged. Inox Equip then called upon Kitchen Vent Technical to design, manufacture and install the kitchen ventilation canopy and services distribution unit.
