

Situation:

KF Bartlett were engaged by Sandy Park Hotel to complete their Catering facilities at the new-build hotel in Exeter adjacent to the Exeter Chiefs Rugby Stadium. There was a requirement for a low odour and maintenance kitchen extract system and so KVT were contracted to design canopies with integral Ultraviolet Filtration and matching Services Distribution Units with accessories. There was also a requirement for the SDUs to have integral pot racks and a salamander grill shelf as a part of the fabrication design.



The KVT Solution:

KVT selected canopies from their ClearAir Spectrum Range featuring integrated UV filtration systems that utilise high intensity UVC light sources to “burn-off” grease & odours from the contaminated airstream which in turn, minimises residual odour to atmosphere and significantly cuts the amount of grease deposited in the ductwork system. Consequently, fire risk and maintenance & cleaning visits are much reduced. Each system is protected with 3 stages of safety control and feature easy access and demounting for maintenance.
