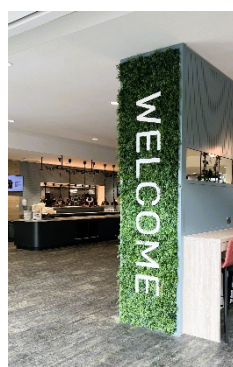
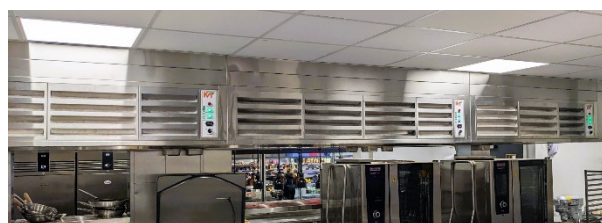
Situation:

Space Group were appointed as Catering Design Consultant for a new build central dining facility at Hartpury University and College near Gloucester. Following a 2-year process, Space Group were also appointed to deliver this fantastic project. There was a requirement for a low-odour and low-maintenance kitchen extract system, so KVT were taken on to design kitchen ventilation canopies with integral Ultraviolet Filtration and matching Services Distribution Units with accessories. There was also a requirement for the SDUs to have integral pot racks and column cladding as a part of the fabrication design.



The KVT Solution:

KVT selected canopies from their ClearAir Spectrum Range featuring integrated UV filtration systems that utilise high intensity UVC light sources to “burn-off” grease & odours from the contaminated airstream which in turn, minimises residual odour to atmosphere and significantly cuts the amount of grease deposited in the ductwork system. Consequently, fire risk and maintenance & cleaning visits are much reduced. Each system is protected with 3 stages of safety control and feature easy access and demounting for maintenance.
