Situation:

PORT STANLEY – FALKLAND ISLANDS:

Appointed by UK company 'Stanley Services' Space Design consultancy were asked to design a brand-new kitchen, bar and restaurant on the remote Falkland Islands. These works required a brand-new ventilation system to facilitate their increased cooking equipment which would be installed by local trade employed by Stanley services. This obviously entailed the need for lots of knowledge & experience as well as the ability to communicate clearly & precisely with third parties and at arm's length. To achieve this, Space engaged with Kitchen Vent Technical Ltd.



The KVT Solution:

KVT selected four canopies from their ClearAir Spectrum Range and to minimise airflows, designed closure panels at each end of the main range. Mindful of the restricted structural heights and the need for simple installation without the usual detailed survey, KVT then worked up a design for a full vent system utilising eight independent, roof-curb mounted fans complete with pre-engineered controls, and heated return supply-air to suit the local climate. Through a series of on-line meetings, detailed drawings, photos, phone calls, emails and instruction manuals, we liaised with the on-site installation teams to complete the project and even attended site to commission ready for opening the following week.
